### HISTORY OF WHITE CROSS

For generations, American Baptists' "helping hands" have been reaching out to people in need. During World War I, women in the church assisted the American Red Cross by providing surgical dressings, bandages and other medical supplies for U.S. service personnel. As they met these needs, the women became convinced that similar methods would be of great help in the work of Christian mission. In 1919, following the end of the war, American Baptist women organized the White Cross Service League, "channeling the war effort into support for Baptist mission."

Through the years, women have provided leadership to this ministry. Today, men, youth, children and entire church congregations have embraced White Cross. They are eager to participate in this ministry by filling specific requests from global servants and international partners. Your gifts received throughout the year provide the needed supplies that cannot be purchased with limited mission budgets.
