\$18,833	Bolivia - Bolivia House of Hope Medical and Dental Supplies
	The House of Hope mobile dental clinic will provide care and prevention resulting in improved oral health. These clinics give the House of Hope the chance to build relationships with Bolivian doctors and dentists thru monthly meetings that build community among the volunteers and offer evangelism and discipleship opportunities. White Cross funds provide equipment and supplies for two mobile dental clinics and one medical clinic each month providing care on a regular basis.

\$7,845	Burundi – Burundi Education
	The Batwa tribe in Burundi live in poor, primitive communities. They exist by hunting and gathering, and are often subjected to racism and discrimination. Educating these vulnerable children will help transform the Batwa community. White Cross funds will provide school uniforms, soap, school supplies like books and pens, and a school lunch. This is an ongoing project for three years.

\$25,490	Africa – Congo Medical Supplies
	White Cross funds purchase hospital supplies, consumables, linens, uniforms, and medicines for Baptist hospitals in the Democratic Republic of the Congo. These funds also pay for transportation costs to get supplies delivered to mostly remote (bush) hospitals and serve poor and rural patients in a country where health care is on a fee for service basis. This is an ongoing project for three years.

\$10,588	Dominican Republic – Dominican Republic Food, School Supplies and More for Haitians

White Cross funds will provide food, hygiene products, school supplies, medications for families, children and the elderly.

	White Cross funds provide hundreds of baby layettes, health, and school kits to benefit the Haitian and Dominican communities in the Dominican Republic. This project will help hundreds of people who struggle each day to provide for their basic needs.

It is anticipated that this project will improve the quality of care and comfort given to all who seek medical help at the hospitals and clinics that provide health services.

\$29,412	India – India Nine Hospital, Clinical and Mobile Units
	Through the Council of Baptist Churches in North East India (CBCNEI), White Cross helps to support nine hospitals, clinics and mobile units that serve in the hills and villages of northeastern India. These services provide much needed medical care to rural communities that would not otherwise have access. Special attention is given to children suffering from malnutrition, and training and awareness camps help deal with human rights, community building and health issues.

	The Chaurajahari Hospital is a 60 bed facility in Western Nepal that is operated by the Human Development & Community Services (HDCS). The goal of this project is to increase and insure accessibility to health services, to reduce the risks of pregnancy and childbirth while addressing factors related to mother and child mortality, and providing free medical care through camps that go to the remote villages. This is an ongoing project for three years.

It is anticipated this project will save lives by improving the level of care given in critical moments by AMOS health promoters.
