MINISTRY STORY

We had arrived in El Salvador, and we were setting up our space in the gymnasium at the Colegio Bautista de San Salvador. The school has proved itself to be a wonderful host. Different persons had arrived to help with set up, sound, and the school nurse came to help with temps and documentation. But the first day of a residency is always a little nerve-wracking. We are forming a community; we are creating a safe place to begin our journey together.

Each student presented themselves, and each person had their own story. This day, there was a heaviness in the room as one student was missing. He was the chaplain at the Colegio Bautista in Santa Ana and had fallen a few days before we arrived. At the hospital they had diagnosed a tumor, and the news had spread that he probably had cancer. We spent time with a shared grief—lifting up this community in pain.

Each time we begin a new cohort, we discover God's handiwork. We discover the stories and how those stories interact with each other. In the Christmas classic *It's a*

Wonderful Life, we learn how each small action can influence the world in immense ways. I am continuously surprised to see how each cohort reflects God's handiwork in unique ways. As each person is faithful and obedient to their call, they show the GOOD WORKS that God has prepared. I am in awe because God is doing so much more through our lives and this ministry. We are indeed "God's handiwork."
