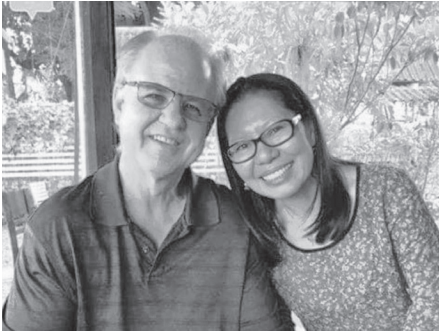

“ MINISTRY STORY

Although born in Thailand, precious Muechi has no documentation. She is considered "stateless," as are many here in Thailand from refugee parents. Her parents from Myanmar are opium addicts. She lived with her grandmother until two years ago, when her grandmother could no longer take care of her. Although in the care and love of her grandmother, Muechi had already experienced much despair and abandonment throughout her short lifetime.

She was delivered to the ITDF Ma Oh Jo hostel with the clothes on her back, a few belongings, and a deep sense of weariness with her head down, barely uttering a word. Here is where her journey ended, and new openings for hope began as she was shown the love of Jesus through her hostel parents, other children, and the ITDF Ma Oh Jo School teachers. Muechi started school and began her new life with much love, care and nurturing, and the academic and life skills needed for a brighter future. It took time and healing, but soon, she became more social and interactive with the other children

within the hostel and more confident in school. Daily nutritious meals also helped her to grow and stay healthy.

Today, two years later, Muechi is thriving both emotionally and academically. She is a bright light shining out of the darkness that this world can bring children. We are excited to see how God unfolds the next chapter in precious Muechi's life.
