A prayer led me to Japan. I first heard the prayer in 2018 on a short-term mission trip to Japan. It was 9:37 a.m., and I was sitting in the backseat of a van headed back and forth between ministry projects. Moments before, I had been looking out the windows at the streets of Tokyo. Then, an alarm pierced the quiet chatter. IM Global Servant Gordon Hwang turned it off and prayed, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Lord, please send more workers to Japan."

Gordon shared that every morning, precisely at 9:37 a.m., he prayed the words of Matthew 9:37-38. That was his prayer for Japan. His faithful, daily prayer had been answered, at least in part, by the arrival of our mission team several days before. That prayer stuck around in my thoughts long after I returned home. Each

time I remembered it, I would add it to my prayers, too. I prayed that God would send more workers to Japan. Well, when you pray for God to send someone, God may end up sending you!
