MINISTRY STORY

One of the most impactful times in ministry in 2021 was when Peter was teaching in Ecuador with the Master of Theological Studies program in Latino/a ministries in partnership with Palmer Seminary and International Ministries. During this week of teaching, the female students of the program were sharing their struggles privately at dinner with Peter. With their permission, Peter took an hour of class time and had the men of the program listen but not respond to each of the women's stories of persecution, abuse, and isolation. When the hour was done, the men were crying more than the women and were seeking their forgiveness and starting to dialogue on

how they can be better leaders together. These moments when we are able to minister in the midst of their context and lives is invaluable. Over the past five years, the McCurdys and other global servants with IM have impacted over one hundred graduates of the program in Brazil, Chile, Bolivia, Ecuador, Colombia, El Salvador, Mexico, Dominican Republic, and the United States.
