"We are in need of theological education in our organization" is what I continue to hear from those I work with around the world. Significant conversations with partners, especially in South Africa and India, have laid some groundwork for collaboration and the development of programs for women and men. Notably, a biennial lecture series on contextual theology will be conducted in South Africa. With the emergence of women in leadership, especially in South Africa, bringing learning opportunities that will focus on theory and practice are being discussed. Important conversations between International Ministries staff and global servants with theological educators in East and South Asia are helpful.
