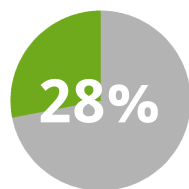

Haiti - Micro-Loans for Women

GOAL

IM seeks to raise \$11,000 in the next year to provide micro-loans to women in Haiti.

SUMMARY

Through micro-loans and training, this project will enable women in Haiti to open small businesses so that they can support their families.

DESCRIPTION

Overpopulation contributes significantly to the poverty problem in Port-au-Prince, the capital city of Haiti. Many people live without running water or electricity and struggle to obtain basic needs.

Madame Jeanne knew these difficulties firsthand. She could not finish school and, as a result, could not find a job or afford medical care. Eventually, because she was unable to pay the school tuition, her children were dismissed from school.

This project will provide micro-loans to Haitian women like Jeanne, enabling them to develop and manage their own small businesses. It will also offer them training through seminars on how a micro-loan works and how to choose and manage a small business. These women will have the opportunity to become leaders who can train others in utilizing micro-loans to develop new sources of income.

SUGGESTED GIFTS
