GOAL

IM seeks to raise \$265 per student for up to 100 students in the next school year

SUMMARY

The Student Tuition Expense Program (STEP) will provide scholarship funds to assist children with financial need and children with disabilities.

DESCRIPTION

IM seeks to raise \$26,500 each year to provide scholarships for 100 children who otherwise could not afford to attend school. Many children with financial needs and specifically those with disabilities are located in one of the poorest areas of the city. The Centro Pedagogico Didaque, a Baptist grade school in Tijuana, Mexico focuses on reaching barrio children. Those who are disabled or need learning assistance are disadvantaged and unable to attend traditional schools.

IM Missionary Patti Long has dedicated her ministry to serving children with special needs and has growing success in seeing many otherwise disenfranchised children learn and grow up to their ability.

Your financial support for STEP Scholarships in Tijuana not only provides meaningful education for special needs children, but also new hope for their parents. When they are able to see how much a child with a disability can develop, the family finds a measure of joy and encouragement for how God loves these special children, thanks to your kindness.
